

PRESS RELEASE

The Rover Sports Register, the oldest Rover club and the only one catering for all Rovers from 1904 to 2005, are holding their National Rally at St. Nicholas Park, Warwick on Sunday the 27th June 2010 from 10 am.

The park flanks the River Avon, and its facilities include a children's amusement park, leisure centre, refreshments and toilets. It is in walking distance of the centre of Warwick with all its attractions. The entrance to the rally site is near Homebase in Emscote Road and not via the public car park for St. Nicholas Park. (Postcode for satnav CV34 4PT.)

The rally is also the first annual event for the Joint Rover Clubs, the informal co-operative group aimed at preserving the Rover marque to which the majority of Rover clubs now belong. All Rovers of any age are welcome and entries so far range from 1906 8hps to 2005 75s. For those booking in advance, there are optional road runs and a dinner, both on the Saturday.
