Our cars will be parked throughout the 41 acre museum site in a variety of interesting and photogenic settings - on the green; in front of a 1930s style transport cafe; out side the exhibitions, and much more.

There is so much to do at Amberley museum, you will be busy all day. There are exhibitions spread across the site. These include the Victorian lime kilns, a history of domestic appliances, history of communications including a working vintage telephone exchange, vintage buses driving round the museum, a vintage bus station and a fire station.

There is a history of road making hall, the old Fairmile Transport Cafe, a narrow-gauge railway, a signal box, a pottery, wood turning and other craft demonstrations. There is an old print works, there are stationary engines and steam engines /rollers.



You can get away from the crowds on the nature trails, there are plenty of places to picnic and the Limeburners restaurant has a wide range of food from snacks to full meals.
